

### **Criteria – Erasmus+ projects**

The school has a set of clearly defined rules considering the principles of non-discrimination, transparency and inclusion of students and staff participating in Erasmus+ projects.

**The students** who show interest in participating in the project are selected according to the following criteria:

- Study results in the previous school year and this year's first term
- Student's interest and enthusiasm shown during their practical and hospital training within their studies at school (max 20 points) – teachers of practical and hospital training award the points
- level of English language – student must have the level A2 or higher – student's knowledge is assessed by the teachers of English language upon an interview and grammar test (max 30 points, student must get at least 18 points)
- student's participation in competitions and other activities out of school curriculum (max 15 points)
- disadvantaged students (those coming from lower social background, orphanages, foster care, etc.) are awarded extra 5 points

**Teachers**, who show interest in participating in the project are selected according to the following criteria:

- expertise and competence in health care (max 20 points)
- the teacher's participation in activities out of the school curriculum (max 20 points)
- knowledge of English language – B1 level or higher – verified by an online test (40 points)
- participating in DVPP (Further education for teachers) seminars within the last two years (40 points)
