<u>Criteria – Erasmus+ projects</u>

The school has a set of clearly defined rules considering the principles of non-discrimination, transparency and inclusion of students and staff participating in Erasmus+ projects.

The students who show interest in participating in the project are selected according to the following criteria:

- Study results in the previous school year and this year's first term
- Student's interest and enthusiasm shown during their practical and hospital training within their studies at school (max 20 points) teachers of practical and hospital training award the points
- level of English language student must have the level A2 or higher student's knowledge is assessed by the teachers of English language upon an interview and grammar test (max 30 points, student must get at least 18 points)
- student's participation in competitions and other activities out of school curriculum (max 15 points)
- disadvantaged students (those coming from lower social background, orphanages, foster care, etc.) are awarded extra 5 points

Teachers, who show interest in participating in the project are selected according to the following criteria:

- expertise and competence in health care (max 20 points)
- the teacher's participation in activities out of the school curriculum (max 20 points)
- knowledge of English language B1 level or higher verified by an online test (40 points)
- participating in DVPP (Further education for teachers) seminars within the last two years (40 points)
