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# Differences in healthcare - Belgium VS CR

## <u>Urinary catheterisation (non-permanent)</u>

- Use of F1/1 instead of desinfection
- Use of sterile tweezers to hold the catheter
- They use vacuette system for the urine
- They use paper tissues insted of cellulose tissues to wipe the genitals

#### **Wounds**

• They dry up the desinfectant F1/1 (not letting it dry)

## **Blood drawing**

- They sometimes use the sarstedt with lancet and vacuette with the "butterfly needle"
- They don't throw out the swab with desinfectant so that they can desinfect their fingers and touch the patients skin during the blood draw
- They don't use gloves

## Infusions

- They have two sets main and side (there's always some solution dripping in the main one they never disconnect the IV set)
- They don't use desinfection much, but F1/1 instead
- They have sheets with rubber bands on the edges -> they don't make knots
- They do hygiene after breakfast
- They have patient's information on the computer
